## Resolution of the Liberty Elementary School District #10 Board of Trustees

WHEREAS following the required 14 days for the publication of the resolution, the Board of Trustees shall take subsequent action to dispose of the real or personal property in a reasonable manner which they determine to be in the best interests of the district.
